



# Town of Leicester Community Electricity Aggregation Program

The Town of Leicester offers Community Electricity Aggregation (CEA), an electricity supply program to provide residents and businesses with new, town-vetted options for electricity supply. The program does not replace National Grid, the electric utility in Leicester; they continue to deliver electricity, repair outages, and handle all billing. Customers will continue to receive only one bill from the utility. The CEA program was approved by Town Meeting in 2014 and launched in August 2021.

## Leicester CEA Electricity Products

Customers may join, leave or switch products offered by Leicester CEA at any time without penalty.

<b>Leicester Standard</b> (standard product)	\$0.10455/kWh	Meets minimum renewable electricity requirements in MA
<b>Leicester 50</b> (optional)	\$0.12410/kWh	50% renewable electricity
<b>Leicester 100</b> (optional)	\$0.14366/kWh	100% renewable electricity
<b>Applicability</b>	Residential, Commercial and Industrial customers	The optional products contain additional Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) above that required by MA law. The additional RECs qualify for MA Class I designation from generation facilities located within, or delivered to, New England.

<b>Residential Customers</b>	\$0.14822/kWh	Meets minimum renewable electricity requirements in MA


**Future savings against National Grid's fixed Basic Service rate cannot be guaranteed** because National Grid's rates change every six months for Residential and Commercial customers, and every three months for Industrial customers. National Grid rates beyond April 2022 are unknown.

## Eligibility

Any electricity customer in Leicester can participate in the program; it doesn't matter whether you are a renter or owner, a resident, a non-profit or a business owner. **There is no obligation to participate and you may leave the Program with no penalty at any time.**

## Participation

How to tell if you're enrolled in the program? Take a look at your National Grid bill - if **Leicester CEA - Dynegy** is listed as the Supplier, you are a participant!



If **National Grid** is listed as your Supplier, you are eligible to join the program at any time at [LeicesterCEA.com](http://LeicesterCEA.com). Allow at least one full meter read (a few days more than a month) for enrollment to be processed by the utility to join the program.

Already have a **different electricity supplier**? Electricity customers who are currently enrolled with a third-party supplier may voluntarily join the program at any time but may be subject to penalties or early termination fees from their third-party supplier if they switch to the electricity aggregation program during the term of their existing contract.
